Introducing our *NEW* Duel-Fuel Heating Program for members of Adams-Columbia Electric Cooperative only.

With rising costs to heat your home, you now have the choice between efficient dual-fuel electric or LP for heating, whichever is the most cost-effective. When LP exceeds \$1.40/ gallon*, our low Duel-Fuel Heating rate of 5.5¢ per kWh is your most economical source of heat.

If your primary source of heat is gas, a plenum heater can easily be installed on your current furnace. This allows you the choice to bypass your gas furnace as your heat source.

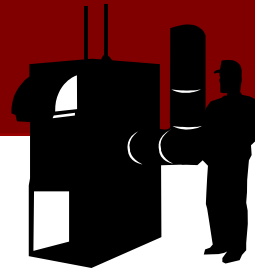
A load management receiver (LMR) is required on all Duel-Fuel units. During peak electrical usage, ACEC could send a signal to the LMR to seamlessly switch back to your propane source. This translates to heat cost savings for the individual homeowner and wholesale power cost savings for *all* ACEC members.

The load management program looks at the electric load on the system as a whole. We are only interested in reducing electric consumption during peak demand periods. Control periods can occur Monday through Friday, between 8:00 am & 8:00 pm. Load management is typically weather-related and most frequently occurs during the irrigation season.

* Calculation based on a 95% efficient gas furnace and zero power cost adjustment.

Adams-Columbia is offering its members a load management rebate of up to \$750 towards a Duel-Fuel Heating system ... which can include the plenum heater, second meter and installation.

Other dual-fuel options are available which also qualify for load management rebates ... such as whole-house ETS (electric thermal storage) units and electric boilers.



ELECTRIC HEAT IS:

Convenient— Electricity is reliable, always available, and runs cleaner than fossil fuels.

Safer— Electric units don't require venting. There's no flame and no potential for carbon monoxide fumes.

Efficient— Electricity operates at 100% efficiency. Running an LP furnace (with a standard operating LP efficiency of 85%) on electricity, will result in savings for you.

Rebate Eligibility and Restrictions:

- Must be online with ACEC.
- Homes must be wired for a second meter to take advantage of our Duel-Fuel Heat rates.
- A load management receiver must be installed on the Duel-Fuel unit by Adams-Columbia Electric Cooperative before a rebate will be given to the member.
- Member must supply the HVAC Dept with copies of all applicable bills.
- Applicable charges include the cost of the plenum heater, customary and reasonable charges for installation of the second meter (including wiring charges by the electrician of your choice), whole-house ETS furnaces, and electric boilers. Gas furnaces are excluded from rebate.
- Products and installation may be purchased through the heating contractor of your choice.
