

PATRONAGE CAPITAL ALLOCATIONS ON MAY'S BILL

What is Patronage Capital?

When you become an ACEC member, you start earning Patronage Capital based on the amount of energy you use. At the end of the year, any funds – called margins – that remain after expenses have been paid are allocated to all members.

The Board of Directors evaluates the financial needs of the co-op every year and determines how much patronage can be returned to members. This is your Patronage Capital Refund. The important thing to remember is that there is a difference between Patronage Capital Allocations and Retirements (Refund).

You will see your ALLOCATION on your May bill. Refunds, or RETIREMENTS, are done later. The Board of Directors will approve the retirement amount in the coming months, after that the refunds are processed. Please note, your ALLOCATION on your May bill is not your refund amount.
