BROADBAND EXPANSION GRANT

This year, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin is offering a Broadband Expansion Grant. Adams-Columbia has joined with Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative and applied for this grant in hopes of bringing better communication options to our area.

This grant would mean additional security for the co-op's communications. We've taken many precautions over the years to keep your personal information as safe as possible and this grant is simply the next step we are taking to continue on that road.

The long-term goal with this grant is to provide broadband communications to each of our substations. This would mean better SCADA (Supervisory Control And Data Acquisition) communications, surveillance, and it would open the door for an AMI (Advanced Metering Infrastructure) system. And lastly, for Marquette-Adams to expand their internet offerings to more communities.

WE GIVE WHERE WE LIVE OPERATION ROUND-UP®


