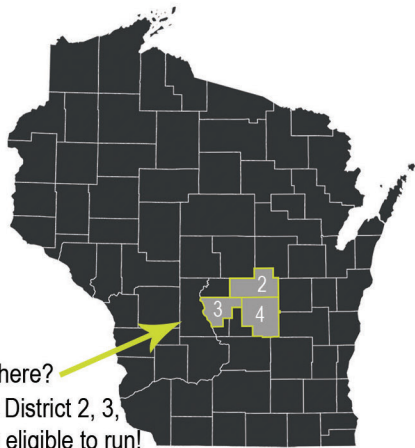
We will begin accepting applications for ACEC's Educational Scholarship January 1, 2019.

How to Run

- 25 Signatures
Collect signatures on a petition - turn it in to the office by 2/8/19.
- Biography
Answer a few questions for our magazine and newsletter to help members get to know you and decide who they should vote for.
- Speech
Give a short 1-2 minute speech at the Annual Meeting before voting.

Once You're Elected

Attend a half day orientation

Attend monthly board meetings

Training: Credited Cooperative Director Certificate - 5 classes within 2 terms (6 years)

Advantages of being a Board Member

- ▶ Make important decisions about the co-op
- ▶ 3 year term - no need to run every year
- ▶ Opportunities to attend state & national conferences
- ▶ Compensation for attending meetings and training
