

PATRONAGE CAPITAL ALLOCATIONS ON MAY'S BILL

What is Patronage Capital?

When a person becomes a member of ACEC, they start earning Patronage Capital based on the amount that is charged on their electric bill. At the end of the year, funds that remain after expenses have been paid - called margins -are allocated to members.

The important thing to remember is that there is a difference between Patronage Capital Allocations and Retirements (Refund). The Board of Directors evaluates the financial needs of the co-op every year and determines how much patronage can be returned to the members. This amount is your Patronage Capital Retirement.

You will see your ALLOCATION on your May bill. Refunds, or retirements, are done later. The Board of Directors will assess the retirement amount in the coming months, after that the refunds are processed. Please note, your ALLOCATION on your May bill is not your refund amount.
