
CLEAN UP YOUR MAIL BOX (AND YARD) BY GOING PAPERLESS!

SAFETY MESSAGE

A generator can be a valuable piece of equipment to keep appliances working during a power outage. Generators can be temporary or permanently installed. If you own a generator, keep these safety tips in mind:

Never operate a generator in a confined space.

Always make sure your hands are dry before touching a generator.

Before turning on a generator, make sure nothing is plugged in.

Remember to keep up with maintenance between uses.

The energy produced from generators may back feed on our system and become an extreme safety hazard for our crews. For the safety of yourself and our crews, **PLEASE** let us know if you have a generator installed.

MAGIC HAWAIIAN PIE

PREP TIME - 15 MINS | COOK TIME - 30-40 MINS

INGREDIENTS

- 4 eggs
- 2 c milk
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 3/4 c sugar
- 1/2 c biscuit mix
- 4 Tbsp butter
- 1 c coconut

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Mix everything together except coconut blend well.
- 2. Stir in coconut.
- 3. Pour into a greased pie tin.
- 4. Bake at 350 degrees for 30-40 minutes. Poke with a toothpick until it comes out clean.

RECIPE NOTES

The pie will set a little more as it cools. The pie makes it's own crust.
