SAFETY MESSAGE

As colder temperatures approach and you reach for your space heater to help you get cozy and warm, make sure you consider the potential dangers of using one. If misused, it can cause electric shock or fire.

- Keep space heaters at least three feet away from flammable items.
- Never leave a space heater unattended while it's running. Turn it off when you leave the room.
- Avoid placing space heaters on rugs or carpets, and keep them on a flat, level surface.

- 2 16.5 oz packages of sugar cookie dough
- 8 oz cream cheese
- 1/4 c sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 8 oz cool whip



Seal drafty windows and doors with caulk and weather stripping.


Unplyg chargers and other electronics when not in use.
