MARASCHINO CHERRY CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES DELIGHT

INGREDIENTS

- 1 c unsalted butter, softened
- 1 c granulated sugar
- 1 c packed brown sugar
- 2 large eggs2 tsp vanilla extract
- 3 c all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 c maraschino cherries. drained and chopped
- 1 c semisweet chocolate chips

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line baking sheets with parchment paper.
- 2. In a large bowl, cream together the butter, granulated sugar, and brown sugar until light and fluffy.
- 3. Add eggs and vanilla. Beat in the eggs one at a time, then stir in the vanilla extract.
- 4. In another bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, and salt. Gradually blend into the butter mixture. Fold in cherries and chocolate chips.
- 5. Drop rounded spoonfuls of dough onto the prepared baking sheets.
- 6. Bake in the preheated oven for 10-12 minutes, or until edges are golden. Allow the cookies to cool on the baking sheets for a few minutes before transferring them to wire racks to cool completely.

Enjoy these delightful cookies packed with sweet maraschino cherries and rich chocolate chips!






WE WANT YOUR PHOTOS
